FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING ADMISSIONS

All Parents and prospective students – Please read the following questions and their answers

Most of your doubts get clarified. Please avoid calling the institute officials over phone. During admission period, it is difficult to answer the calls. In case your doubts are not listed in the FAQ's please send a brief email to nitandhraadm@gmail.com.

1. How is the climate in NITAP?

Ans: The region of Tadepalligudem, where our NIT Andhra Pradesh is located, experiences rains from June to November. It is advised that students may come prepared with raincoats and/or umbrellas.

2. What is EAA?

Ans: EAA is Extra Academic Activity. It is a ZERO credit, compulsory course. All the First year students have to compulsorily participate in the 'EAA' course, where Sports, Games and other physical exercises are practiced by the students. Students may come prepared with proper shoes, and sportswear such as T-shirts and lowers. Minimum attendance of 80% is essential.

3. When will the class work start for B.Tech I year students of 2017-18 batch?

Ans: Class work will start from 16th August 2017(Wednesday). Students and parents may come on 15th, or 16th and get admitted in the Hostels.

Orientation programme will be held on 16th August 2017. In this programme the Institute Administration including Faculty will address the students and parents.

Class work will start from 17th August 2017(Thursday).

4. What is the Academic schedule?

Ans: It is 6 days a week during the I semester and Sunday is a holiday. From the second semester onwards, it is 5 days a week and Saturday and Sunday are holidays.

5. What is the Curriculum being followed?

Ans: NITAP, Tadepalligudem is being mentored by NIT Warangal. So, the curriculum syllabus academic rules and regulation as that of NIT Warangal are implemented in Toto at NIT Andhra Pradesh, Tadepalligudem also. From this academic year 2017-18 revised curriculum and Rules and Regulations are being implemented.

6. What is the availability of Hostels?

Ans: NITs are basically 100% residential campuses. So, in NITAP also, hostel facilities are being provided. All the students are required to stay in the hostels only. However, students from nearby places, who want stay with their Parents/Guardians have to take prior permission from the administration. Such students have to make their own transport arrangements as per the college timings.

7. What is the quality of food in the Messes?

Ans: Every effort is being made to provide hygienic food to the students.

8. What type of accommodation is provided in the Hostels?

Ans: In the Girls Hostels 3-students are there in each room. In the boys Hostels, depending on the room size, students will be accommodated.

9. What are the arrangements for medical assistance?

Ans: The services of Part-Time Doctors are being hired. A Lady Doctor is available in the Ladies Hostels everyday evening for 3 hours. Similarly, in the Boys' Hostel also a male Doctor is available in the evening.

Two ambulances, one near the girls' Hostel and one near the boys' hostel are available 24x7.

10. What is the status of faculty and staff?

Ans: MHRD, GOI has sanctioned 67 faculties and 73 Non-Teaching staff positions. Steps are being initiated to recruit them. Meanwhile, 68 Adhoc faculty have been selected.

11. What is the status of permanent campus?

Ans: The State Govt of Andhra Pradesh has allotted 172 acres of land, and the compound wall construction is nearing completion. Efforts are being made on fast track mode to construct buildings in the permanent campus and shift by the beginning of the next academic year 2018-19.

12. When did the institute start and where is it located?

Ans: In the academic year 2015 – 2016.

An area of 172 acres has been allocated for the institute in Tadepalligudem, West Godavari Dist. The institute is temporarily located at Sri Vasavi Engineering College campus, Pedatadepalli, Tadepalligudem – 534101.

13. How to reach the institute?

Ans: Tadepalligudem is the nearest railway station on Vijayawada – Visakhapatnam main line. Airports near the town are Vijayawada (100 Km) and Rajahmundry (60 Km).

From Tadepalligudem railway station or bus stop on the bye-pass, autos will be available. The temporary location is about 10 Km from Tadepalligudem railway station.

14. What are the programs offered at the?

Ans: Bachelor of Technology (B. Tech)

15. What is the mode of admission?

Ans: Admissions are based on the All India Rank obtained at JEE (Mains) examination.

16. What are the eligibility criteria for admission?

Ans: The criteria for admission in to the institute are same as that of JEE (Mains) examination.

17. Is there any quota for NRI or other foreign national students?

Ans: No. At present students are admitted only through JEE (Mains) All India Rank. Students from other admission streams like DASA, ICCR, MEA etc. are not considered at present.

18. When will M. Tech and PhD programs commence?

Ans: They are not planned now. It may take about 3 to 4 years to start these programs

19. What is the website for the institute?

Ans: Website for the institute is www.nitandhra.ac.in

20. What are the courses offered in B. Tech and what is their intake?

Ans: B. Tech is offered in 8 branches with a total intake of 480 seats. The number of seats in each branch are indicated in brackets.

Biotechnology (30), Chemical Engineering (30), Civil Engineering (60), Computer Science & Engineering (90), Electrical & Electronics Engineering (90), Electronics and Communication Engineering (90), Mechanical Engineering (60), Metallurgical & Materials Engineering (30)

21. How many seats are reserved for home state and other states?

Ans: In each branch 50% seats are reserved for home state students and other 50% seats are for other state students

22. What is the home state for the institute?

Ans: Andhra Pradesh State

22. I am born in Vijayawada, studied up to X standard in Vijayawada but intermediate at Hyderabad. Will be considered under home state quota for NIT Andhra Pradesh?

Ans: NO. As per the home state definition of CSAB, your home state will be Telangana and hence you will be considered under Other State quota for admission in to NIT Andhra Pradesh. For further details regarding home state and other state, refer to CSAB website and admission brochure.

24. Is the institute completely residential?

Ans: Yes. All the students are expected to stay in the hostels

25. I am from Tadepalligudem / my parents live in Tadepalligudem. Can I attend the institute as day-scholar?

Ans: You need to take day-scholar permission by submitting proof for the above

26. I have got 175 marks in JEE (Mains) and 98% marks in my 10+2 examinations. Can I get a seat in NIT Andhra Pradesh?

Ans: Admission in to any NIT does not depend on the marks obtained. It depends purely on the All India Rank. Please wait till the ranks are announced by CBSE.

27. What are the opening and closing ranks of the students admitted last year?

Ans: The Opening (OR) and Closing Rank (CR) of different category of students admitted to NIT Andhra Pradesh are available in the institute website www.nitandhra.ac.in.

28. How many seats are available branch-wise, category-wise?

Ans: The seat matrix of institutions for the academic year 2016 – 2017 will be available in CSAB website. The same information with respect to NIT Andhra Pradesh will be made available in the institute website.

29. Do you have branch change at the end of first year?

Ans: Yes. It is possible to change the branch at the end of first year. The curriculum for first year is common to all branches. At the end of first year based on the performance in the first two semesters, students can opt for change of branch. Change of branch is permitted subject to availability of seats and CGPA of the students at the end of first year.

30. What are the placements and pay packages?

Ans: As the first batch has just completed first year, it is too early to talk about placement
