1. Bioscattergorries :

In this game, ten different topic names are written on cardboard papers, each having a distinct letter mentioned on the reverse side. These cards are placed on a table. Two teams are then selected, and each team draws one card at random. Based on the card drawn, the team must provide a correct answer that matches the given category and begins with the specified letter. The team that responds first with the correct answer is declared the winner. The event encouraged quick thinking, active participation, and enthusiastic involvement from the faculty members, making it both engaging and enjoyable.

2. Guess the Object :

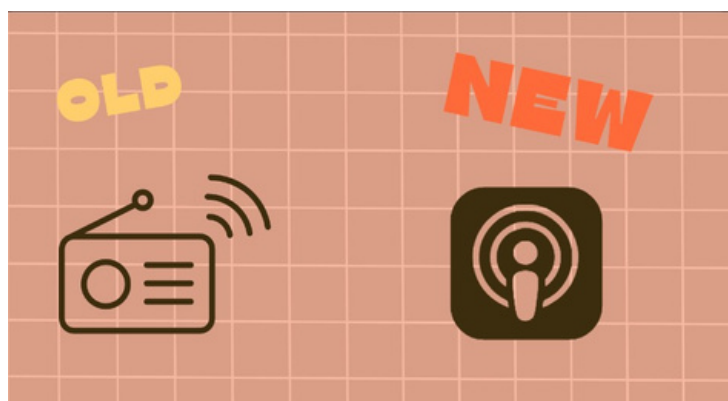
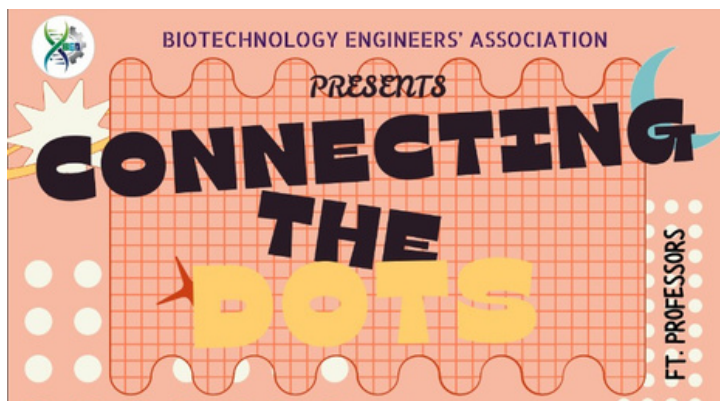
This game's main objective is to find the object. A Black & White image of an object is projected on the screen. The participants must guess the object inside the time limit.
