Congratulations to all candidates who have been **provisionally admitted** to the **B.Tech. programme** at **NIT Andhra Pradesh** for the **Academic Year 2025–26**.

- All admitted candidates are required to report physically to the Institute for original document verification and completion of the admission process, as per the schedule mentioned below.
- The Inauguration and commencement of classes for the admitted candidates will begin from 25th August 2025.

2. Hostel & Reporting Instructions for Admitted Students

- Students are **required to bring their luggage** when arriving for the admission process, as they will be staying on campus after reporting.
- After completing physical reporting and document verification, students must report to the Hostel Office to complete the hostel accommodation process.
- Hostel accommodation will be provided to all admitted candidates within the campus.
- A separate notice regarding the hostel registration process will be issued by the Hostel Office and made available on the Institute website.
- The Induction Programme and commencement of classes will begin on 25th
 August 2025. Attendance is mandatory for all admitted students.
- Candidates are advised to visit the Institute website frequently for the latest updates and announcements.

3. Payment of Balance Institute Fee:

Provisionally admitted students are required to pay the Balance Institute Fee (after adjusting the seat acceptance fee and partial admission fee through JoSAA/CSAB-2025) during 20th Aug-23rdAug 2025. The details of the balance institute fee are provided in the table below:

^{*} MEB- Most Economically Backward (Annual Income below 1 Lakh (maximum allowable Rs.99,999/-)); OEB -Other Economically Backward (Annual Income between 1 lakh to 5 Lakhs (Maximum allowable Rs.4,99,999/-)) candidates are also required to pay balance Institute fee (Rs.17,100/-) at the time of physical reporting. After verification of the income certificates the remission amount will be refunded to the student. Separate notice will be issued for submitting documents regarding the fee remission process and to claim the refund of excess fee paid by the candidates (if any).

NOTE: Institute caution deposit is refundable at the time of leaving the institute after deducting dues, if any.

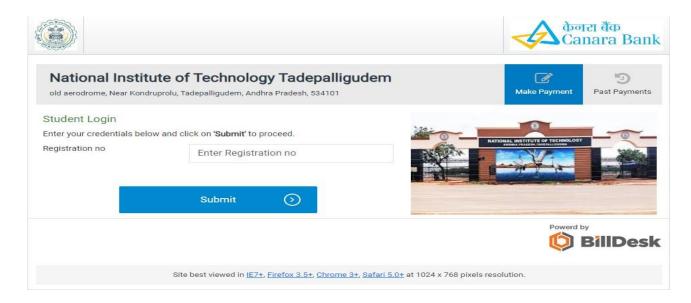

(The OBC-NCL and EWS certificate should be issued on or after April 1, 2025, as per JoSAA/CSAB-2025 prescribed format. In the certificate it should be clearly mentioned that the candidate belongs to non-creamy layer.)

- > Certificates for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable.
- Medical Certificate [As per JoSAA/CSAB-2025 recommended format Annexure-7 available on the JoSAA website]
- Aadhaar Card of the candidate.
- Copy of the Bank passbook (Student/Parent)/ crossed cheque- for getting refund amount (if any).
- Please arrange all the original certificates (as applicable) and two sets of selfattested photo copies (as specified) in the same sequence as given in the above, while reporting for admission to the campus.
- > Recent colour passport size photographs-2.

Note: Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra state government must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate. ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state government must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.

Candidates, who fail to produce the relevant category certificate (OBC-NCL/EWS/ST/ST/PwD certificate, as the case may be) as mentioned above, the allotted seat will be cancelled at the time of physical reporting.
