HOSTEL OFFICE

All the graduands of 2016-2020 and 2017-2021 batches of UG program are hereby informed you that hostel accommodation during the 2nd & 3rd convocation is provide with strict adherence to COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). In view of this each student has to go through the following safety measures and resident responsibilities and act accordingly.

Safety Measures:

1. Need to follow the queue management, inside and outside the allotted messes (dining hall No: 01 of Kamdhenu mess for Boys and Dining hall no:03 of Amrutha mess for girl students.
2. Movement of each student at every entry and exit points should be monitored. Crowding must be avoided at entry/ exit points of allotted hostel block.
3. Density in dining halls, common rooms, playing areas should be limited, keeping in view the requirement of physical distancing.
4. It must be ensured that the meals are freshly cooked. Utensils should be properly cleaned. A senior staff should monitor the same
5. Wearing of face covers/ masks and proper sanitization of hands of the staff engaged for the preparation and distribution of meals should be ensured.
6. Hostels may define the number of students in dining halls at any point in time. Mess timings may be increased to avoid overcrowding.
7. Sharing of books, other learning material and eatables are strictly not entertained.

Role of Students:

1. Self-discipline is most important to avoid the spread of COVID-19 pandemic through social distancing and maintaining hygienic condition.
2. As the students are coming from different locations, they shall not interact with juniors residing in the hostels and not enter into their hostel premises. No crowding among the students while roaming inside the campus.
3. There should be no crowding in allotted hostel areas where students live in close proximity and share common facilities and utilities. Hence, their numbers need to be limited appropriately to avoid crowding. Students co-operation with the mess management is highly appreciated.
4. All students should wear face covers/ masks and take all preventive measures while availing mess facilities.
5. May consider installing 'Aarogya Setu App' in the mobile if not done.
6. Discrimination of fellow students in respect of whom there is a history of COVID-19 disease in the family is avoided. Give support to your friends under stress due to COVID-19 pandemic.
7. Students should follow the guidelines, advisories and instructions issued by the Government authorities as well as by the Institute regarding health and safety measures in view of COVID-19 pandemic.
