**Institute Level Spot Round Counseling for Admission to M.Tech.
Programmes (A.Y. 2026–27)**

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for **Institute Level Spot Round Counseling** for admission against vacant seats in various **M.Tech. programmes at National Institute of Technology Andhra Pradesh** for the Academic Year 2026–27.

Candidates seeking admission must submit their application online and report **physically in person** at the Institute campus as per the schedule detailed herein.

2. Application Procedure and Guidelines

- (a) **Online Registration:** Candidates must complete the online application registration form available at: <https://forms.gle/GGvcMcFnqRCKhkH39>
- (b) **Application Processing Fee (Non-refundable):**
- (i) **GEN / OBC-NCL / GEN-EWS Categories:** ₹1,500/-
 - (ii) **SC / ST / PwD Categories:** ₹1,000/-
 - (iii) **Application Fee Payment Portal:**

- (c) **Submission and Reporting Deadlines:**
- (i) The deadline for online registration is **09:25 AM on 12 August 2026**.
 - (ii) The candidature of candidates who complete online registration shall be validated only upon their physical reporting at the designated reporting venue. Candidates who fail to report physically by **09:30 AM on 12 August 2026** shall have their online registration treated as **null and void**, and no further claim for admission or consideration arising out of such online registration shall be entertained.
 - (iii) Submission of the online application form and completion of the registration process shall not automatically guarantee or confer any right to seat allotment. Seat allotment shall be made strictly in accordance with the prescribed admission procedure, eligibility criteria, availability of seats, and the applicable rules and regulations of the Institute.

3. Eligibility Criteria for Spot/Institute Admission

Eligibility criteria for admission are the same as specified in CCMT-2026. Please refer to the official [CCMT-2026 Information Brochure](#).

(a) Qualifying Degree and Academic Requirements

- (i) **Academic Criteria:** Candidates must possess a B.E. /B.Tech. /M.Sc. or equivalent degree from a recognized university/institute with the minimum academic criteria specified by CCMT-2026:
 - (1) **GEN / GEN-EWS/ OBC:** 6.5 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 60% aggregate marks.
 - (2) **SC / ST / PwD:** 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 55% aggregate marks.
- (ii) **Degree Mapping:** Mapping of qualifying degrees to specific M.Tech. specializations is as per CCMT-2026 mapping rules.
- (iii) **Eligible Disciplines:** To check eligible branches for each program, visit the CCMT portal: [Home>View Mapping of \[Institute, Department, PG Program\] VS \[GATE Paper & Qualifying Degree\]](#)

(b) GATE-Qualified Applicants:

- (i) Candidates possessing a valid GATE scorecard (for the year **2024, 2025, or 2026**) are eligible for seat allocation in the first priority phase.



(ii) Admitted GATE-qualified candidates shall be eligible for Ministry of Education (MoE) Post Graduate (PG) Scholarship / Half-Time Teaching Assistantship (HTTA), subject to fulfillment of institutional norms and availability of funds under MoE schemes.

(c) Non-GATE Applicants:

(i) In the event that seats remain vacant after exhausting all eligible GATE-qualified applicants in a given specialization, applications from Non-GATE/Invalid GATE candidates shall be considered.

(ii) Except for the relaxation in valid GATE score, all other academic criteria and qualifying degree mapping remain identical to CCMT-2026 guidelines.

(iii) Selection of Non-GATE candidates will be based on a screening examination and/or interview conducted by the respective academic department on the day of reporting.

Note: Candidates admitted under the Non-GATE category shall **not** be entitled to any MoE PG Scholarship / HTTA or Institute financial assistance.

4. Details of Vacant Seats

(a) Publication of Seat Matrix:

(i) The tentative vacant seat matrix (department-wise and category-wise) will be published on **August 06, 2026** following the conclusion of the CCMT-2026 National Spot Round (Phase-III) on the [Institute Official Portal](#).

(ii) Any additional vacancies arising after the physical reporting of CCMT-allotted candidates will be published on the [Institute Official Portal](#) on **August 11, 2026**.

(b) Seat Conversion Rules:

If category-specific seats remain vacant after exhausting all eligible candidates in that category:

OBC-NCL → OPEN

GEN-EWS → OPEN

SC → OPEN

ST → OPEN

PwD seats within any category will be first offered to non-PwD candidates of the same category, then follow the above conversions.

5. Fee Payment and Admission Process

(a) Institute Fee:

(i) Candidates who are provisionally allotted a seat shall be required to pay the Institute Fee of **₹59,600 (Rupees Fifty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred only)**, applicable to all categories, on the day of physical reporting, i.e., **12 August 2026**, to confirm their admission. Failure to remit the prescribed fee on the stipulated date and time shall result in cancellation of the provisional seat allotment, and no further claim for admission shall be entertained. Any seat so vacated or cancelled shall be offered to the next eligible candidate present in the spot admission round, strictly in accordance with the merit order and the applicable admission rules.

(b) **Academic Enrollment:**

(i) Successful fee payment must be followed immediately by completion of Academic Enrollment & Semester Registration at the Admission Desk.

(c) **Hostel & Mess Charges:**

(i) Hostel accommodation and mess charges are separate and subject to availability and compliance with Institute Hostel Regulations.

6. List of Documents Required at the Time of Physical Reporting

Candidates must present all **Original Certificates** along with **one set of self-attested photocopies** at the time of document verification:

(a) **Proof of Age / Date of Birth:** Class X Certificate / Marksheet issued by a recognized Board containing Date of Birth.

(b) **Senior Secondary Education:** Class XII Pass Certificate and Marksheet.

(c) **Qualifying Degree Credentials:** B.E. / B.Tech. Degree Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate and Consolidated Marksheet (CMM) / Semester-wise Marksheets.

(d) **GATE Scorecard:** Valid GATE Scorecard (2024, 2025, or 2026), if applicable.

(e) **Category Certificate:** SC / ST / OBC-NCL / GEN-EWS / PwD Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the Central Government prescribed format. (*Crucial Cut-off Date: OBC-NCL and GEN-EWS certificates must be issued **on or after April 01, 2026**, (Maharashtra candidates must provide a Caste Validity Certificate).*)

(f) **Transfer Certificate (TC):** Issued by the last attended Institution/University.

(g) **Migration Certificate:** Issued by the last attended Board/University.

(h) **Conduct & Character Certificate:** Issued by the Head of the Institution last attended.

(i) **Medical Fitness Certificate:** Issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner in the prescribed format.

(j) **Identity Proof:** Government Photo Identity Card (Aadhaar Card / Passport / Voter ID / Driving License).

(k) **Photographs:** Minimum two (2) recent passport-size colour photographs.

(l) **Course Completion Certificate / Undertaking:** Course Completion Certificate or Undertaking for Late Submission of Documents in prescribed CCMT format (for final semester result-awaiting candidates, if applicable).

(m) **Bank Account Proof:** Cancelled cheque or passbook copy displaying Student Name, Account Number, and IFSC Code.



7. General Instructions

- (a) **Mandatory Physical Attendance:** Physical presence of the candidate is strictly mandatory. No representation through proxy, authorization letter, or virtual mode shall be entertained under any circumstances.
- (b) Seat allocation shall be carried out strictly in order of merit based on choices submitted in the application form:
- (i) **GATE Candidates:** Merit list prepared strictly in accordance with CCMT-2026 merit criteria.
 - (ii) **Non-GATE Candidates:** Merit prepared based on
 - (1) Prior GATE qualification (if any),
 - (2) Marks secured in the Departmental Written Test and/or Interview.
- Note: The decision of the Departmental Selection Committee shall be final and binding.*
- (c) Once a seat is allotted and accepted, no request for branch/specialization transfer shall be entertained. Furthermore, in the event of seat cancellation/ withdrawal, no refund of fee shall be admissible under any circumstances.
- (d) No Travelling Allowance (TA) or Daily Allowance (DA) will be paid by the Institute for participating in the counseling process.
- (e) The Institute reserves the right to amend, alter, reschedule, or cancel any stage of the Spot Round process without prior notice.
- (f) Provision of false information, concealment of material facts, or submission of forged/tampered documents will lead to immediate cancellation of admission, forfeiture of all fees paid, and initiation of appropriate legal action.
- (g) In case of any dispute or ambiguity regarding the interpretation of rules, the decision of the **Chairperson, Senate, NIT Andhra Pradesh** shall be final and binding on all parties.

Important Note:

Admission is strictly **provisional** and subject to the satisfactory verification of original documents upon physical reporting, confirmation of academic eligibility, submission of fee payment receipts, and full compliance with all institutional policies and CCMT-2026 regulations.
