### **PREMEABLE:**

National Institute of Technology, Andhra Pradesh is the 31st NIT among the chain of NITs started by the Government of India. NIT Andhra Pradesh is established in the state of Andhra Pradesh in the academic year 2015 – 2016.

Sealed tenders (percentage rate) are invited under two bid system i.e., technical bid and financial bid from reputed contractor/contracting firms registered for the Recommissioning and construction of Tubewells at NIT Andhra Pradesh Campus

### **SCOPE OF WORK:**

#### **Bidder Scope:**

Recommissioning and Construction of Tubewells at NIT Andhra Pradesh Campus.

- Drilling of tubewells (Borewells)
- Flushing of existing tubewells (Borewells)
- S, I, T, C of motors, pump sets and control panel boards
- Providing and fixing PVC casing pipe
- Providing and fixing PVC slotting pipe
- Gravel packing
- Supply and laying of HDPE Pipe
- Construction of brick masonry
- Plastering
- Other electrical, civil and plumbing related works

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

1. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specification 2019 Vol-I & II with up-to-date correction slips. For the items which are not covered under CPWD Specifications; B.I.S. specifications shall apply. In this regard the decision of Engineer-in- charge shall be final.
2. Unless otherwise specified, the agreement rates for all items of work of the schedule of quantities are for all heights, depths, leads and lifts involved in the execution of work.
3. On account of security consideration, there could be some restrictions on the working hours, movement of vehicles for transportation of materials. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions and adjust the program for execution accordingly, for which nothing extra shall be paid.



4. The work shall be carried out in a manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant bye laws of the local bodies, Labour Laws, minimum wages act, workmen compensation act and other statutory laws enacted by Central Govt. as well as State Govt.
5. No residential accommodation shall be provided to any of the staff engaged by the contractor. The contractor shall not be allowed to erect any temporary set up for staff in the campus.
6. All required register will be issued by Engineer-in-Charge/Executive Engineer duly marked in chronological order but the contractor will have to arrange all such registers/stationery etc. Nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
7. No claim whatsoever for idle labour, additional establishments, costs of hire and labour charges for tools and plants etc. would be entertained under any circumstances.
8. For the safety of all labour directly or indirectly employed in the work for the performance of the contractor's part of this agreement, the contractors shall, in addition to the provisions of Safety code and directions of the Engineer-in-charge make all arrangements to provide facility as per the provisions of Indian Standard Specifications (Codes) listed below and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
  - (a) IS 3696 Part I Safety Code for scaffolds and ladders
  - (b) IS 3696 Part II Safety Code for scaffolds and ladders Part II ladders
  - (c) IS 764 Safety Code for excavation work
  - (d) IS 7969 Safety Code for storage and handling of building materials
  - (e) IS 5216:1982 code of safety procedures and practices in electrical works
9. The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid all accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards and by providing red flags, red lights and barriers. The contractor shall be responsible for any accident at the site of work and consequences thereof.
10. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to govt. property or allotter "property by his or his labor in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
11. All taxes, Labour Cess etc., as applicable shall be borne by the contractor himself. The contractor shall quote his rates considering all such taxes including GST on works. Any recovery towards GST is notified by the competent authority, the same shall be affected and no claim what so ever shall be entertained by NIT Andhra Pradesh. The contractor shall quote his rates accordingly.
12. Chases, holes & drilling works etc. shall be done using power operated tools in the cost of contract. No extra will be paid for the same.
13. The agency shall restore back the premises and other articles provided by the department to the department at the time of closure of the contract.

14. In the case of discrepancy between the schedule of quantities, the Specifications and/or the Drawings, the following order of preference shall be observed: -
- Description of schedule of quantities.
  - Additional specifications and special conditions, if any.
  - Contract clauses of General conditions of contract for Central P.W.D. works.
  - CPWD specifications.
  - Architectural drawings.
  - Indian standards specifications/BIS. (vii) Sound engineering practice. Any reference made to any Indian standards specifications in these documents, shall imply to the latest version of that standard, including such revisions/amendments as issued by the Bureau of Indian Standards up to last date of receipt of tenders. The contractor shall keep at his own cost all such publications of relevant Indian Standards applicable to the work at site.
15. The contractor and /or his authorized agent should see the site order book every day and get the compliance of instruction given by the JE/AE/EE (E-I/C) as per time schedule.
16. In addition to the provisions of relevant clauses of the contract, the work shall also be open to inspection by the Engineer-In-Charge, NITAP and other senior officers of NITAP and his authorized representative. The contractor shall at times during the usual working hours and at all times at which reasonable notices of the intention of the Engineer- in-Charge or other officers as stated above to visit the works shall have been given to the Contractor, either himself be present to receive the orders and instructions or have a responsible Site Engineer duly accredited in writing, to be present for that purpose Senior Officers of NITAP Authorities shall also be inspecting the on-going work at site at any time with or without prior intimation.
17. All the debris during the execution of work shall be cleared every now and then and site shall be kept clear by the contractor at all times.
18. The contractor has to make his own arrangements for the watch and ward of the materials and other installations till the installation / work is completely handed over to the department. No extra claim will be entertained on account of this. Any damage to the materials during or under storage will be to the contractors account.
19. No quantity deviation is permitted without written approval of the competent authority. Permissible deviation shall be sanctioned by the competent authority as per the agreement. Deviation beyond permissible limits shall be sanctioned by the competent authority as per the prevailing Local Market Rates only and the decisions of the department is final and binding on the contractor.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

1. The bidder should have a valid GST Certificate.
2. Bidder must have any one of below registration certificate
  - a. CPWD Class-V (or) above
  - b. Any state government PWD Class-IV (or) above
  - c. Any Organization of state/Central government organization Class-I (or) above.
3. The bidder must have a valid PAN Card and the same should be reflected in all financial statements.
4. The average annual turnover of FY. 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24 should be at least 9 Lakhs issued by CA with UDIN Number.
5. The bidder should submit audited financial statements (balance sheets) for the FY 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 along with relevant income tax returns for the concerned years i.e., AY 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25.
6. Bidder must have successfully completed the works pertaining to the establishment of Civil infrastructure with the conditions and value of work/purchase orders along with satisfactory certificates defined as under during the period of 01-04-2021 to 31-03-2024.
  - One work pertaining to the establishment of Civil infrastructure costing not less than the amount equal to Rs.17,32,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Lakhs Thirty-Two Thousand only).

## **EVALUATION PROCEDURE:**

1. At the first stage, the Technical Bids shall be opened in the presence of Bidders, who may like to be present on **11.11.2024 at 03.30PM.** in **Material Management & Disposal Section,** Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Administrative Vista Building of NIT Andhra Pradesh, Tadepalligudem.
2. IPC would evaluate the technical bids submitted by the Bidders.
3. Prior to detailed evaluation, the Institute will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the tender document. A substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the bidding/tender document and is without any material defects and deviations. Deviations from, or objections or reservations to critical provisions such as those concerning qualification/eligibility criteria, availability of facilities and amenities as needed, availability of government/statutory approvals and clearances, ready and explicit willingness to accept and honor the terms and conditions of contract etc. will be deemed to be material deviations.
4. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Institute and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
5. Only those Bidders whose technical bids have been found to be substantially responsive would be evaluated.
6. The Financial bids of those Bidders only shall be opened who qualified in the Technical Evaluation. The Institute will award the contract to the Successful Bidder, whose financial bid is the lowest price bid among all the quoted bids. The decision of the Director, NIT Andhra Pradesh, Tadepalligudem, is final in this regard. In case of a tie, the contract will be awarded to the firm that has the highest Average Annual turnover for the last three years.
7. Tenders with revised/modified rates/offer after opening of the tenders shall be summarily rejected and the entire Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) submitted with the tender shall be forfeited.
8. The tender is not transferable under any circumstances.
9. Telegraphic, conditional or incomplete tenders shall not be accepted. Canvassing of any kind, directly or indirectly shall lead to disqualification of the Bidder.
